The Series

The 2020 **USQ Queensland HPV Super Series** will consist of eight events across Queensland. The series is for single seat, non-hybrid HPVs, which comply with the Queensland HPV Super Series Vehicle Specifications.

To be eligible for Series point's teams must register for the series and pay a nominal fee. The fee includes one set of race numbers for the year, and entry into the championship. All teams are encourage to compete in at least two of the shorter course races and any one of the endurance races. Any combination of the race events is acceptable including competing in multiple Enduro events.

The Method

Each event is controlled and run by the hosting school/organisation, using the agreed upon QLD HPV Standard Set of Rules and Regulations. After the event all race results are to be forwarded to QLD HPV Super Series administration for championship point's allocation and tracking.

Each school is to register **ALL** their teams by the **1st of JUNE** through QLD HPV Super Series administration for a fee of \$25 each. This cost includes vehicle identification race numbers and automatic entry into the Queensland HPV Super Series. The vehicles will use the same race number all season. A set of 3 high quality decals will be mailed to your school after your fees are paid. **Late registration will incur an additional admin fee of \$20.**

All championship results will be posted on the QLD HPV Super Series Web site.

Note: This fee does not cover any race entry fees.

The Categories & Prizes

Prizes will be awarded to first, second and third placings for the following categories:

Senior Boys	Junior Boys	Restricted Class Boys
Senior Girls	Junior Girls	Restricted Class Girls
Senior Mixed	Junior Mixed	Restricted Class Mixed

Multiclass 1 (Special School)

Multiclass 2 (SEP Unit)

Highest placed School built bike will be recognised for Seniors, Juniors and Restricted.

Juniors are students in Yr. 7 through to Yr. 9 inclusive.

Seniors can be Yr. 7 through to Yr. 12 inclusive.

Mixed teams must comprise of equal number of boys to girls or more girls than boys.

Note: Restricted Class is a vehicle with less than 50% aerodynamic advantage, built or bought. Contact QLD SS Admin for verification.

The trophy winners will be announced and presented at the end of the presentation ceremony at the last race of the season.

To be eligible for a category prize the vehicle must run in the same registered category to receive championship points.

Any category changes requires the TEAM Manager to email the QLD HPV Super Series Admin of the changes for the points to be allocated correctly.

The Scoring

Only the best three race results per team will go toward championship points. Points will be awarded for every category as follows: For **short courses**, 10 pts for first, 9 pts for second, 8 pts for third and so on with every team after 9th position receiving 1 point. For **Enduro courses**, 20 pts for first, 19 pts for second 18 pts for third and so on with every team after 19th position receiving 1 point.

The team with the most points at the end of the series in each race category is the winner. If you race two or more enduros, your highest points will remain and your other results will transfer back to a rating out of 10 points only and this can be counted as one of your short course events. Additionally, 1 bonus point will be tallied for every event your team competes in adding to your total score.

To be eligible for state championship prizes each team must compete in at least one of the shorter course events and one of the four Endurance events.

For teams that finish on the same number of points after the last round, the difference will be decided by the team with the quickest average speed for the season, this includes **all** of the team's races.
